The Federal Register notice of the 2013 poverty guidelines is available. The poverty guidelines are sometimes loosely referred to as the "federal poverty level" (FPL), but that phrase is ambiguous and should be avoided, especially in situations (e.g., legislative or administrative) where precision is important.

Each year Obamacare's cost assistance eligibility levels are based on the Federal Poverty Level Guidelines that are already in place at the start of open enrollment (Nov 15, 2014, for 2015, Nov 1, 2015, for 2016). For 2016, premium subsidies, cost-sharing assistance, and taxes are based on the 2015 Federal Poverty Guidelines.

In October 2013, the poverty level became relevant to millions more Americans. That's when the health insurance exchanges for Obamacare opened for enrollment. Those making 400% or less of the poverty level became eligible for tax credits to help pay for insurance costs.

Federal Poverty Level: Definition, Guidelines, Chart

As a point of reference, at the time of this writing, the annual FPL for a household of one is \$12,760 (\$1,063 / month). And the maximum annual SSI benefit amount for a single individual is \$9,396 (\$783 / month). As with the FPL, many assistance programs use SSI figures to determine if an applicant is income eligible.

2013 Federal Poverty Guidelines (FPL)

The poverty guidelines are a federal poverty measure. They are issued each year in the Federal Register by the Department of Health and Human Services (HHS). In vast majority of our cases, to be eligible for our services, your household income may not exceed 125% of the federal poverty guidelines.
